# **Employee Fund**

The Employee's Fund is operated by a committee made up of staff representatives from various departments. This is funded by a voluntary payroll deduction from employees and funds are distributed to fund Members for the following events:

- Free Admission for Members to Agency Holiday Party
- Free Admission for Members to Agency Summer Event
- \$500 Scholarship for Employee's Graduating Senior (2 annual awards)
- \$5.00/year Employed to a max of \$100 upon Retirement from the Agency
- \$50 for each of the following life events:
  - Over Night Hospitalization
  - (Member, Spouse/Domestic Partner, or minor child through HS graduation)
  - Death of a Parent, Spouse/Domestic Partner, or Child
  - New Birth or Adoption to Member or Spouse/Domestic Partner
