SNAP provides food benefits to supplement your grocery budget so you can afford the nutritious food essential to health and well-being

How does SNAP work?

If approved, you will receive benefits on an Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card each month.

- Meat, poultry, and fish
- Dairy products
- Breads and cereals
- Other foods such as snack foods and non-alcoholic beverages
- Seeds and plants, which produce food for the household to eat
